Fatality

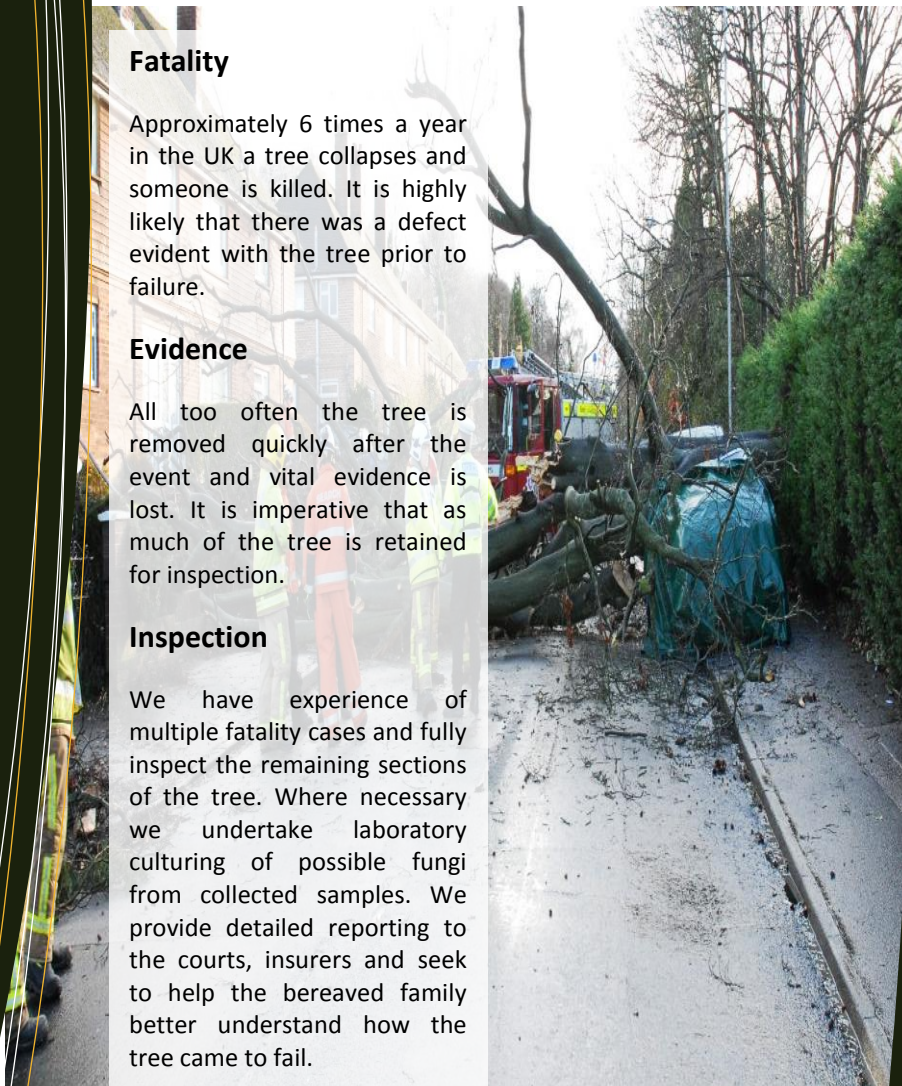
Approximately 6 times a year in the UK a tree collapses and someone is killed. It is highly likely that there was a defect evident with the tree prior to failure.

Evidence

All too often the tree is removed quickly after the event and vital evidence is lost. It is imperative that as much of the tree is retained for inspection.

Inspection

We have experience of multiple fatality cases and fully inspect the remaining sections of the tree. Where necessary we undertake laboratory culturing of possible fungi from collected samples. We provide detailed reporting to the courts, insurers and seek to help the bereaved family better understand how the tree came to fail.
